Rules for Equipment Use:

The "Climber Guidelines" (applies to the climber and the outdoor slide) are posted on the wall behind the climber. The 4's-5's receive verbal instructions, given by the teacher, at the time of the activity.

Instruction on Supervising Outside Large Motor Equipment: Same as above

Instruction on Supervising Inside Large Motor Equipment: Same as above

All Adults Carefully monitor all Children: Especially those who are using the Active Equipment

Location of Children's Medical Information: Emergency cards are in the kitchen by the first aid (right of the sink).

Location of Posted Allergy Information: General allergies (i.e. No Peanuts) posted on the kitchen cabinet door above the sink. Specific allergies (none at this time) posted on the right cabinet above the sink.

Location and Use of Latex Gloves: Found in the First Aid Kit and on the shelf directly above the sink.
Use to avoid contact with blood or bodily fluids

Know Medication Policies:

In specific circumstances, the Co-op may have a policy of giving prescription medication to a child.

If the policy includes giving prescription medication to a child, the teacher:

1. Shall give prescription medications as authorized, in writing, by a physician or other person legally authorized to prescribe medication;
2. Shall accept prescribed medication from the parent, in the original container labeled with the child's name, date prescription was filled, expiration date and with legible instructions for administration;
3. The prescription medication is stored appropriately; and
4. Shall keep a record of prescription medication disbursed and provide a copy for the parent.

Syrup of Ipecac may be kept at the Co-op but shall be used only with the advice of a licensed physician or poison control center.
